

ASGEB Master's Fellowship – 2025

The Arab Society for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (ASGEB) is pleased to announce its Master's Fellowship Program for its members from newly graduated Egyptian students in Biotechnology for 2025. This competitive fellowship aims to support outstanding graduates by providing funding for academic and research activities related to their master's thesis.

The fellowship covers:

- 1. A monthly stipend of 2,000 EGP (net).
- 2. Research expenses, including chemicals, consumables, use of laboratory equipments, and bench fees where applicable in specific cases.
- 3. Publication costs for any research papers derived from the thesis in Q1 journals (Q2 journals may be considered in specific cases).
- 4. The fellowship is awarded for one year, with the possibility of renewal for a second year based on the student's performance evaluation.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria:

- 1. The applicant must be Egyptian and a recent graduate.
- 2. Eligible degrees include graduates from the Faculties of Science, Agriculture, or Pharmacy, preferably with a specialization in biotechnology.
- 3. The applicant must commit to working in the lab at least 3 days per week (part-time), with preference given to full-time availability.
- 4. The fellowship will be implemented at the National Research Centre (NRC), Dokki, Giza.
- 5. The applicant must have achieved a minimum overall grade of "Very Good" in their bachelor's degree (B.Sc.).
