



ASGEB Best Young Researcher Award 2025

The Arab Society for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (ASGEB) is pleased to announce the Best Young Researcher Award (BYA) 2025 for its members under the age of 45 working in the field of Biotechnology. This award aims to recognize excellence in biotechnology research among young Arab Scholars, promote their scientific contributions, and enhance communication of their work within the wider community.

Award Details:

- A symbolic monetary prize of 10,000 EGP (Net).
- Three awards will be granted annually in the following thematic areas:

Agricultural Biotechnology, Medical Biotechnology, and Industrial Biotechnology

- Winners will also receive:
 - A certificate of recognition, Lifelong free membership in ASGEB, and an opportunity to actively participate in ASGEB's scientific programs, conferences, training programs, and workshops.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria:

1. Must be a young biotechnology researcher under the age of 45.
2. Must be based in an Arab country.
3. Must have at least two international peer-reviewed publications, one of which must be in a Q1 journal.
4. All applications will be evaluated according to international standards and the applicant's bibliometric data.

As part of ASGEB's commitment to transparency and self-assessment, the following will be made publicly available: A brief profile of each winner, including qualifications and evaluation rankings. A list of the top 10 shortlisted applicants to enable open comparison and benchmarking.
